## Mackay Christian College Instrumental Music Scholarships

Mackay Christian College (MCC) offers a limited number of Instrumental Music Scholarships as outlined below. Our scholarship program is designed to identify students who demonstrate a strength and developing expertise in music providing them with quality Christian education and music tuition for them to progress and be challenged in a nurturing environment. Eligible applicants are students who meet the criteria as stated within the individual scholarships. All Instrumental Music Scholarship applicants are required to submit an Instrumental Music Scholarship Application Form.

### **Full Instrumental Music and Academic Scholarship (valued up to \$6400.00):**

- There will be one scholarship offered each year to new students enrolling at MCC. This scholarship includes all College fees, instrumental lessons, the cost of examinations for the instrument that the student was awarded the scholarship and may include instrument hire if required. Short-listed applicants will be requested to audition
- Auditioning applicants will be asked to perform 2 contrasting pieces of music with a total duration of 5 to 8 minutes. Aural ability, sight reading and general knowledge of their chosen pieces will also be tested
- Applicants should have reached Grade 4 AMEB or equivalent on their chosen instrument which would be required in an ensemble at MCC. They should be a proven academic achiever obtaining excellent results of A's and B's or equivalent over the past 2 years
- Successful candidates will be prepared to meet the following criteria:
  - a. Perform in at least one College ensemble or as required
  - b. Choose Music as one of your elective subjects in Middle and Senior School
  - c. Help in training and motivating younger instrumental players
  - d. Maintain academic levels of A's and B's while attending MCC

### **Half Instrumental Music and Academic Scholarships (valued up to \$3200.00 each):**

- There will be a maximum of two scholarships offered each year to new students enrolling at MCC. These scholarships include half College fees, half the cost of instrumental lessons, half the cost of examinations for the instrument that the student was awarded the scholarship and may include instrument hire if required. Short-listed applicants will be requested to audition
- Auditioning applicants will be asked to perform 2 contrasting pieces of music with a total duration of 3 to 5 minutes. Aural ability, sight reading and general knowledge of their chosen pieces will also be tested
- Applicants should have reached Grade 3 AMEB or equivalent on their chosen instrument which would be required in an ensemble at MCC. They should be proven academic achievers obtaining good results of A's, B's and C's or equivalent over the past 2 years
- Successful candidates will be prepared to meet the following criteria:
  - a. Perform in at least one College ensemble or as required
  - b. Choose Music as one of your elective subjects in Middle and Senior School
  - c. Help in training and motivating younger instrumental players
  - d. Maintain academic levels of A's, B's and C's while attending MCC

### **Full / Half Instrumental Scholarships (valued up to \$1100.00 each):**

- There will be a maximum of eight scholarships offered to enrolling and current students. These scholarships include either half or full cost of instrumental lessons and may include instrument hire if required. Preference will be given to those applicants who would greatly benefit from being an active member of the Creative Academy at MCC but without financial assistance would be unable to participate
- Short-listed applicants may be requested to audition
- Applicants should have reached Grade 2 AMEB or equivalent on their chosen instrument which would be required in an ensemble at MCC. This should be demonstrated in the audition
- Successful candidates will be required to perform in a College ensemble or as required

### **Additional notes:**

The College requires that all applicants and their families support the College's mission and ethos in full. Eligible applicants are those who are aligned with, and supportive of the College values and fulfil the requirements outlined within the individual Music Scholarships. The College reserves the right not to offer a scholarship or scholarships in a particular year or within a specific category. Scholarships are approved for one school year and will be continued if requirements are maintained. Applications will be considered for approval by the Head of Faculty, Creative Academy, in consultation with the College Principal.

### As a student, I will:

- attend all lessons, ensemble rehearsals and performances on time
- bring all my music, diary and instrument to lessons and rehearsals each week
- maintain a regular practice routine of at least five 15-20 minute practices per week
- care for and maintain my instrument and replace consumable items when needed
- treat the teachers and the conductors with the utmost respect
- be a part of an ensemble at the College if one exists for my level
- assist with the setting and packing up of ensemble equipment
- participate in all performances
- strive for excellence in my performances

### As a parent/guardian, I will:

- support my child in all aspects of their instrumental instruction, including home practice, punctual arrival for rehearsals and performances
- contact my child's conductor/teacher if my child will be absent or late to lessons and rehearsals through the Front Office or by email before 8.30am
- contact my child's conductor if they are unable to attend any performances in advance (minimum 2 weeks' notice)
- provide music books, music diary, consumable items such as reeds, rosin, valve oil etc. at my own cost
- encourage, monitor and help maintain my child's regular practice routine of at least five 15-20 minute practices per week
- acknowledge my child's regular practice routine by signing the music diary
- volunteer my time to assist with fundraising, assist transporting instruments to Eisteddfod or other community performances, sewing or Creative Academy run activities etc. (e.g. Bunnings Sausage Sizzle, M.O.B. Festival)
